## PROPOSAL DEADLINE: January 24, 2020

We are now accepting applications for **WORKSHOP PRESENTERS** for the upcoming 2020 *Celebrating Salish Conference*. Selected presenters will offer a 90 minute workshop on a topic of their choice during the conference. We are looking for language presentations on topics ranging from classroom teaching techniques, language technology, classroom activities, use of songs/arts, curriculum development, story-telling, and everything in between.

Preference will be given to proposals from teachers/people that are actively teaching in their communities. We want to hear about what you are doing in your communities to revitalize our language. If selected, you will be asked to present your workshop TWO TIMES during the conference.

Last year we had over 40 workshop proposals, so please submit your proposal by the deadline. Emailed proposals are preferred. Once I receive your proposal, I will send you a quick reply to let you know "I got it". And, if selected, I will contact you for additional information.
